See if you can find the answers to the following questions in the written text below some of the dioramas, and in the showcase of Presidents and First Ladies.

1. The Declaration of Independence was drafted by five people. Two of them were Roger Sherman and Robert Livingston. Who were the other three?
2. Christopher Columbus received help from what royal couple to pay for his voyage that ultimately led to the discovery of The New World?
3. In the year 1620, how many Pilgrims set sail on the Mayflower which landed at Plimouth Colony? (Plimouth is the historical spelling of the colony name. In more recent times it is usually spelled as Plymouth.)
4. What do the Red, White and Blue colors in the United States flag represent?
5. He was a leader of the Constitutional Convention and its oldest delegate. His earlier experiments proved lightning was, in fact, electrical. Who was he?
6. This frontiersman was a Congressman from Tennessee and well known for his famous coonskin cap. Who was this American hero and at what famous battle did he die?
7. In part because his own wife was deaf, he worked to invent a hearing and speech device to assist the deaf, which led to his greatest invention. Who was he and what was his famous invention?
8. This great scientist worked most of his career in Tuskegee, Alabama. He did experimental work with peanuts, sweet potatoes, and cotton. He was named after one of our greatest Presidents. Who was he?
9. The 19<sup>th</sup> Amendment to The U. S. Constitution granted women the right to vote. These two ladies worked tirelessly their adult lives on behalf of Women's Rights. Who were they?
10. These two brothers were actually bicycle makers and flew their first machine powered plane December 17, 1903. Who were they and where did this first airplane flight occur?
11. One of the figurines in the showcase of Presidents and First Ladies is seated. Can you discover which one?
12. Which President was tallest? Which was shortest? Can you tell from the Presidential figurines?
