Key Responsibilities

- Prepare and serve specialty coffee beverages in a timely, craft-conscious manner
- Maintain comprehensive knowledge of specialty coffee standards, including:
 - Ratios and recipes
 - Espresso machinery operation and maintenance
 - Milk texturing and traditional drink preparation
 - Craft techniques and industry terminology
- Accurately execute POS transactions and cup labeling systems
- Keep counters, coolers, and service areas stocked and organized
- Maintain cleanliness in dining, bar, and kitchen areas
- Assist with food preparation as needed
- Foster a hospitable, professional, and guest-focused atmosphere

Required Qualifications

- Thorough to comprehensive knowledge of the specialty coffee industry
- Excellent customer service and communication skills; team player
- Ability to multitask in a fast-paced environment while maintaining quality standards
- Dedication to the craft of specialty coffee
- Creative thinking and problem-solving abilities

Preferred Qualifications

- Minimum of 3 years' experience in the specialty coffee industry (independent or craft-focused shop experience is preferred)
- Experience in food handling

Certification Requirement:

SERV Safe Food Handler certification is mandatory upon acceptance of the position (testing required), regardless of prior food handling experience.

Work Environment & Physical Requirements

- Indoor work environment
- May become noisy during peak rush periods; generally calm and community-oriented atmosphere
- Requires memorization and execution of drink recipes, food recipes, labeling systems, and POS procedures
- Ability to lift and carry items weighing 2–10 lbs. (e.g., milk jugs, portable beverage dispensers, refrigerated goods)
